Greetings, salutations, and a wag of my tail from Overland Park, Kansas!



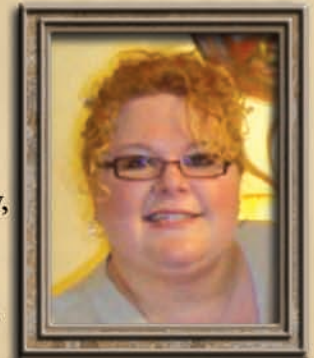

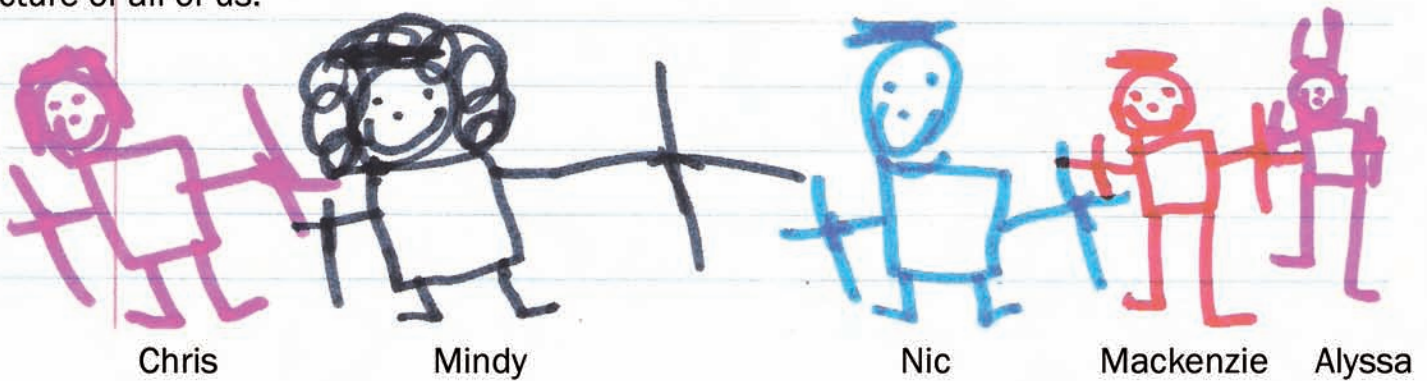
